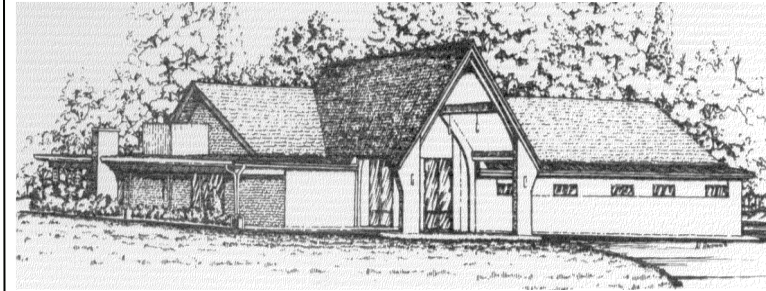

1 Thessalonians

These two letters (*1 & 2 Thessalonians*) were written to real people who were experiencing real problems in a world that was not friendly to their Christian faith. You and I can easily identify with these people because we live in a similar world and face many of the same problems. Once you understand the background, the burden, and the blessing of these two letters, you will see how up-to-date and practical they are.

The first Wednesday of August, we will begin a study of the book of 1 Thessalonians. I hope you will begin to read and study from this book. The past three Wednesday nights, I have handed out questions from this New Testament letter. Would you look at these questions and be ready to jump into this study about a church that was in some ways a model congregation?

Eastwood, we need to be people of the Bible. We need to be better prepared when we come to Bible study. Please bring your Bible. Do not just come to hear what someone says, but come with your sword in hand, and learn from Paul himself as he wrote to this good church.

One writer, which I have been reading from, has written that chapter one is titled "Contagious Christianity." That is what we must learn from this letter; to live lives that are contagious to others.
